

#### **STEERING BOX REPAIR**

In the words of Willie Nelson, after 3 months up on jack stands in the garage, my Bird and I are "On the Road Again"! Summer touring was cut short on July 30 when I pulled her out of the birdhouse for Shelly to take to a Vintage Chevrolet Club sponsored event and....wait a minute....maybe that's the problem right there. The pretty bird didn't want any part of hanging with a bunch folks wearing Bowties! Anyways, a seal on the steering box let loose and fluid proceeded to blow out all over the driveway. At least she was kind enough to dump all her fluids at home...the car that is.

What to do? Well, I knew what to do but just not how best to go about it. Two days later was the police and fire demonstration event at Target in Abingdon of which MATC was invited to show some of our Thunderbirds. I went (in a Ford) and yakked it up with everyone else. Bill Clark was there with his gorgeous '66 convertible. He told me that replacing the steering box was not for the faint at heart. Very difficult. His advice was to contact Jim Wulf, the ITC tech advisor for my '63. I did. Jim could not have been more helpful with advice on how to do the job and where to obtain quality parts and service. He also warned me that this was not going to be an easy undertaking.

For anyone who has ever worked on one of these models, you know, nothing is easy to get to. Add factory air conditioning and you've really got to be a contortionist and have a variety of socket accessories with knuckles. The steering box does come out but not without removing support brackets, exhaust pipes, stuck pitman arm and swing away steering wheel coupling. The job is complicated by the fact nearly every vacuum hose, brake line, hydraulic line, accelerator linkage, transmission linkage, master cylinder, A/C hoses and tons of wiring all are located and or snake through this area. To add insult to injury, the box weighs nearly 50 lbs. As explained by Jim, it is absolutely a two person job to lower it out once everything is disconnected and moved out of the way. One person must hold the box from above using a healthy strap and another works underneath to support the devil and maneuver it out. For what seemed like an hour of twisting, lifting, turning, finagling and finger squashing, this box which now felt like a ton, wiggled out of the bottom of the car. While I was at it, I decided it was best to replace the pump and hydraulic lines. This is complicated because this is one of the models that uses the power steering pump to operate the windshield wipers. Brilliant.

Where to obtain parts and service? Jim's priceless advice was not to purchase at a local store or any of the well-known Tbird parts dealers. Unfortunately, the quality just isn't there. He provided names of two shops that would rebuild the units in a superior manner. I chose Lares corporation located in Minnesota. They actually already had a replacement pump available and would rebuild my box and return it in about 3-4 weeks. They were wonderful to deal with and the price was very fair. I shipped off my greasy old box and 3 weeks later it was returned looking brand spanking new along with detailed but simple instructions on how to install, align and center the wheels and fill and bleed the system. Wonderful. I highly recommend them.

My bird has always been rather lazy when I step on the gas. The pedal always felt like I was stepping on a wet sponge and the 300 horses never seemed to want to get up and go. While the steering box was out, I decided to look into this. I climbed on top of the engine and had Shelly pump the accelerator pedal while I looked down the carburetor throat. Lo and behold, the primary butterflies were opening only half way! A little adjustment and the problem would be solved so I thought. Nope. Adjustment was already maxed out. There's an odd mechanism between the firewall and the cylinder head where the linkage goes through to the pedal. The whole contraption was sloppy. Strange. Called Jim Wulf again. Jim instantly knew the problem. There's supposed to be a little bracket bolted to the rear of the bell housing to provide support for the accelerator linkage. This bracket is often lost and/or forgotten when the transmission is removed. Mine was missing. A call to Pat Wilson and \$20 and I had one on my doorstep in two days. What a difference!

I finally got the car back together a couple weeks ago and took a couple short rides to sort things out. Last Thursday the real maiden voyage was the drive to Bel Air for the monthly MATC breakfast. No problems. After breakfast, I drove about 2 hours taking care of various errands around town. After not having the car for 3 months, I was pleasantly reminded why I love this car. It is such a dream to drive. Quiet, comfortable, stylish and now with some real power on hand...or is that on foot! I want to thank Jim Wulf and the rest of the Thunderbird community for all their help, advice and sympathy throughout this process. It's great to be a part of this group. Phil Hack
