One of the bright spots for car guys and gals during the doldrums of winter are the major collector car auctions. And so far this season the news for TBird enthusiasts has been good. At Mecum in Kissimmee, a 2005 Cashmere sold from over \$34K, and a 290 mile '03 sold for over \$35K, both including the buyer's premium. And a '63 "M" Code sold for over \$46K, including buyer's premium. The 55-57s have done well too, with many selling in the \$50-60K range and one hammering down at over \$150K. Let's hope this is a trend that continues.


