1957 Thunderbird William & Charisse Clark, Bel Air, Maryland

William's Thunderbird features the F-code supercharged engine that represents the pinnacle of factory-sponsored team racing in NASCAR. The car was delivered new in Minneapolis with just two options: the race-ready 312

Thunderbird Special V-8 and a heater/defroster unit. Only 211 F-code Thunderbirds were built, and just 17 of those featured the 3-speed manual gearbox such as William's car.
