

AACA Thunderbird Award







In 2012 the Antique Automobile Club of America (AACA) introduced a new National Award - The Thunderbird Award. It is presented in the name of the Earl Tindol Family, in recognition of the Ford Thunderbird and its role in automotive history. This award is given to the most outstanding Thunderbird at one or more of the 15 annual judged events sanctioned by the AACA each year. The candidates are subject to a very stringent judging process to be considered for the recognition. The Thunderbird Award was first awarded in 2012 based on candidates from the 2011 show season. I am surprised it took this long for the AACA to give special recognition these iconic automobiles. MATC is very fortunate to have two winners of this prestigous award associated with our club. In 2012, Tom Young and his late wife Linda were the second winners of the award for their phenomenal 1960 Hardtop. Bill Clark and his wife Charisse received the award in 2017 for his very rare 1957 F Code. The award as shown in the above photos is on display at the brand new AACA Headquarters and Library facility in Hershey PA. I wonder when we will see a retro TBird owner as the recipient of the award?
