BRIEF HISTORY of the MID-ATLANTIC THUNDERBIRD CLUB, By Bea Zastrow

In the early'70's or before, Carl Davis, (now deceased), formed the Mid-Atlantic Chapter of the Vintage Thunderbird Club of America, MAC Chapter-VTCA. Sometime later the VTCA expanded and changed its name to Vintage Thunderbird Club International VTCL.

Carl led the MAC Chapter until the mid1980's when he said that he wanted to step down, and asked for a volunteer to take his place. No one stepped up and I finally offered to do it, hopefully assuming that my gender would not be a problem. Carl accepted my offer and declared me President of MAC in 1986. Kitty Mummert became the Club treasurer. It was all very informal.

Starting in 1991, Sandy Schatz, the treasurer of VTCI, felt that some of the expenditures he was asked to pay did not conform to the VTCI bylaws. She was told to shut up and pay them. She refused and the VTCI seized the books. The MAC Chapter and several other VTCI chapters asked for an explanation from the VTCI Board of Directors. We heard nothing, so, without taking sides, we then made a <u>formal</u> request for an audit. Again no response, so the chapters decided/voted to withdraw as chapters from the VTCI. These chapters then became part of the nucleus of the International Thunderbird Club which was formed in late1993. The first ITC convention was held in the summer of 1994 in Syracuse, NY.

The VTCI Mid-Atlantic Chapter became the independent Mid-Atlantic Thunderbird Club. I felt we needed some formal paperwork identifying the Club and I consulted one of our members, Bob Amos, who was an attorney. He said that MATC doesn't do anything that requires the formality of incorporation, which can be a hassle with its legal requirements, so he helped to set up our Rules for Operation.
