MATC Picnic In The Park

To celebrate **Thunderbird Appreciation Day** this year, we have reserved a pavilion for Sunday, May 16, 2021 from 11am to 3pm at Deer Creek Picnic Area in Susquehanna State Park. The picnic area address is just Halls Crossroads MD 21078. The best way to get there without winding through the park is to take Price Rd off Darlington Rd (Rt 161) which you will turn onto either from Rt 1 or from Rt 155 coming from I95 or Bel Air. At the dead-end of Price Rd, bear to the right onto Stafford Rd. After you cross a small bridge, look for the picnic area sign on your right. There is a \$2 per vehicle entrance fee unless you have a MD Golden Age Pass or are a veteran in which case you note that on the envelope at the gate and tear off the tab to put on your rearview mirror. Everyone must stop at the gate to get that tab for your vehicle.

The club will provide plates, napkins, silverware, cups, etc., and some drinks. We ask each family to bring their own food once again. Just to be safe. Bring lawn chairs if you can. There are nice bathrooms.

Who's Who In MATC

In my travels to various Thunderbird events and activities, especially outside of the primary service area of MATC, I am often asked "how are Ray and Jean Raeke doing?". Jean and Ray are almost synonymous with the Mid-Atlantic Thunderbird Club and the TBird hobby. They have been members of MATC for almost 40 years which certainly puts them in the legacy status of club members. Both have served on the MATC Board as officers and Ray is currently a director. They have been VTCI and ITC members and were there when the transition occurred in 1993.

Ray became involved in the Thunderbird hobby like many others. His first TBird was previously owned by a family member. The 1963 landau that most of us are familiar with was purchased new by Ray's dad for his mother, but she did not like driving it, so it was passed on to Ray. It is truly a single family, almost single owner, car. Jean and Ray also own a 1968 Landau that they purchased when they first were married nearly 50 years ago. It is currently under restoration. And there is a third Thunderbird in their collection too. It is a 1961 convertible that is a parts car.

From a personal standpoint, Ray is a retired master plumber. He owned Raymond Raeke & Son until his retirement. Ray is the son in the company name-the business was established by his father. An interesting extension to typical plumbers' responsibilities for Ray was the installation and service of roof drains for large commercial structures. I know many of us can recall Ray discussing some of the interesting projects he was involved. Jean was a beautician, a career she mostly discontinued after their son Chuck was born. Many of us remember seeing Chuck at Thunderbird functions in the past when he was a youngster. Chuck is now married and has three children which are the pride and joy of Jean and Ray.

Jean and Ray have stayed involved with MATC for many reasons. These include the people they have met, the friends they have made, and attending the many social events, conventions and gatherings they have participated in over the years. They are somewhat limited in how much participation they will be able to be involved in going forward because of Ray's health. I know I can speak for all of the MATC members and others in the TBird hobby that have known Jean and Ray for a long time in saying that we look forward to enjoying their involvement for a long time into the future.

Is It Time To Retire?

- If your tires are older than 6-7 years, you should consider replacing them. Check with the tire manufacturer or a reputable tire dealer for specific recommendations for your specific tires brand. The below photo shows how to tell how old your tires are.
- Even if the tire has a lot of tread, but the tire sidewall is old, dry and has small cracks, it would be better to replace the tire with a new one.
- The recommended minimum height of a tread is 3 mm (4/32") for summer tires and 4 mm (5/32") for winter tires. An easy way to gage whether it might be time to replace your tires is to use the penny rest. Place a penny Lincoln's head first in between the tire treads. If you can see the top of Lincoln's head, it is probably time to replace the tires. See diagram below. Check with a reputable tire dealer too.
