# Pot Luck Social July 10



















### From The Editor:

Zoeanne and I thank you for attending the Pot Luck Social. 2016 is the third year we have hosted the event and each time we have enjoyed sharing our home with MATC Members. We are looking forward to attending the next Pot-Luck Social at John and Phyllis' log cabin. At the Third Thursday Breakfast, John Horn was lamenting his problems securing the door mounted rear view mirrors on his 1966 Thunderbird. He had a problem keeping the mirror tight and in the process of reattaching the mirror he

dropped and lost the set scew and was now driving with out the mirror. John wanted to know what the set screw size so he could purchase another. I had difficulty securing my right side mirror tightly also. When the set screw was tightened all the way it reaches the end of the internal threads and falls out. I corrected the problem by installing a 1" long #8-32 phillips head screw that was  $^{1}\!\!\!/\!\!\!/$ " too long but secured the mirror very tight. After breakfast I went home and determined that my left side, rear view mirror was also loose. The supplied screw for the mirror was a  $\#8-32 \times 5/8$ " long set screw. When I tightened the screw it wedged into the threads and I could not remove the allen wrench. The cure is to use a  $\#8-32 \times 3/4$ " long set screw. This is an uncommon set screw size that is not available at the local hardware store. I searched the internet and found the screws for sale in bulk quantities. I purchased a box of 25 and have plenty to share. Check your side view mirror attachment on your 64-66 Thunderbird, you may need a longer set screw. same problem. I will bring the extras with me to the Thusday Breakfast and the Cherry's Festival. Finally, my apologies to Kathy and Bob for misspelling their last name in the last Newsletter. My excuse: Spell check let me down.
