## **All Ford Nationals 2020**

This year was a dual recognition for the annual All Ford Nationals gathering at Carlisle, PA. It was the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary for the event and there was a 65<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration for our Thunderbirds. The promoters of all of the Carlisle events have had numerous challenges this year because of COVID19. At first it appeared that none of the ten or so events would take place because of restrictions by the CDC and the state of PA. The state of PA even filed suit to prevent the Spring Carlisle event, and the others, from taking place. Somehow the Carlisle folks were able to convince the authorities that these events could be held in a safe, controlled manner. AFN was the third event to be held in 2020.

Tom Young and I ventured to AFN on Friday of the four day event. The weather looked very iffy so we did not make a final decision until Friday morning. I left home in a drizzle at about 7am, but by the time I met Tom along the way, and we actually crossed into PA, the rain subsided for the rest of the day. We arrived at Carlisle in mid-morning. The Thunderbird parking area was much better than usual. It was actually within a brief walking distance to the main display and vendor areas. But the impact of COVID was evident in that the number of Thunderbirds on the show field was much less than typical. There were around 12-15 when we arrived and a few more by the time we left in the late afternoon. A sampling is presented in the attached photos. The number of other Fords was much less also as was the number of vendors. There were plenty of Mustangs as on the show field, but again, fewer than typical. I understand that Saturday attendance was similar. Overall, it was a much different experience than I have been accustomed to. One big downside was that many of the TBird friends I look to socializing with were not there. But there were a few familiar faces. There were a few bright spots. One was the TBird display in Building "T" in recognition of the 65th anniversary. Several generations of our Birds were represented. The banners on display were also very cool and represented each generation of Thunderbird. Also, one of our MATC members, Calvin Hansford, won the second place award for his 2003 in people's choice/participant judging. Congratulations Calvin.

We all hope for a "normal" event next year.









### Maryland State Parks (Senior) - Golden Age Pass

Adults, ages 62 and older, are entitled to free day use entry (cardholders only) to all State Parks that charge service fees. This pass is valid for half price camping (excluding full service cabins and houses) for one site Sunday through Thursday. Pass holder must be part of the camping party during the entire stay. The boat launch fee at Maryland State Parks is eliminated for seniors who possess a Golden Age Pass. The pass holder must present the pass at check-in. This pass is non-transferable. The Golden Age Pass can be purchased online. There is a one-time service fee of \$10.00 to process the pass. Seniors must purchase a new pass to replace any pass that is lost or stolen.

**Day-Use Waiver for Veterans** - All applicable day-use entrance charges are waived for all veterans of the United States Armed Forces. This waiver applies to both resident and out-of-state veterans. This waiver is applicable to the veteran only and not others in the same vehicle, unless a per-vehicle charge is in effect at the time. In that case, the per-vehicle fee is waived. No other facility use service charges will be waived.

### The National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Senior Pass

- \$80 Lifetime Senior Pass
- \$20 Annual Senior Pass
- Available for: U.S. citizens or permanent residents age 62 or over. Applicants must provide documentation of age and residency or citizenship.
- How to purchase:
  - In person at a federal recreation site (see PDF list of federal recreation sites that issue passes)
  - Online—buy the **lifetime pass** or the **annual pass** online now through the USGS store!
  - Through the mail using this application form (PDF).
  - NOTE: There is an additional cost of \$10 for passes purchased online or by mail. See more information about changes to the Senior Pass.
- Additional information:
  - The Senior Pass may provide a 50 percent discount on some amenity fees charged for facilities and services such as camping, swimming, boat launch, and specialized interpretive services.
  - The Senior Pass generally does NOT cover or reduce special recreation permit fees or fees charged by concessioners.
  - Golden Age Passports are no longer sold. However, these passes will continue to be honored according to the provisions of the pass.
