

Who's Who In MATC

My interest in Thunderbirds started in 1988 when my Brother John decided to purchase a 1957 Thunderbird like our Uncle had in 57. I was involved with the hunt for the right car, and trailered it home for him from Virginia. In 1992 I decided I wanted an old car to tinker with and found my 1960 Thunderbird. I did not set out to buy a Thunderbird, I just wanted an old car to drive. For 15 years previous to purchasing my Thunderbird, I was Drag Racing a Dodge Charger that I bought new in 1973

Now I have 2 cars with a limited budget, a wife and a daughter to occupy my time and money. As far as cars, the racing was first, so I had little time and money for the Thunderbird until 1997, when I stopped racing. The Thunderbird was already apart in my garage, so I got serious about building the Bird as a show car for the Antique Automobile Club of America (AACA).

I watched the progress on my Brother's car being professional restoration by Marvin Hill. I did my best to replicate the finish the Pro's were getting on my own car. This was my first restoration, and it turned into a long process that was not finished until 2006.

I have been very fortunate to win "The AACA Thunderbird Award", which is given to one Thunderbird a year, out of many shown. I also won "Best of Show" in 2009 at the Vintage Thunderbird Club International Convention in Ohio.

In 2005 my wife Linda was diagnosed with Alzheimer's, and I spent the next 10 years caring for her. We were both active in MATC, and the ITC club, attending 14 ITC Conventions, and making some great friends along the way. The MATC people were always supportive and helpful to Linda and I through the years.

After Linda passed in 2016, I continued being active in multiple car clubs. I was fortunate to meet Linda Rodgers who is now my Thunderbird Partner in crime! In 2017 I decided to buy a Retro Bird to drive since my 60 Bird is a "Trailer Queen" with only 170 miles on the odometer since 2006! Linda likes an "old guy" with a red convertible!

I am a past President of MATC & The Chesapeake Region AACA. I am a current Board member, and Swap Meet Chairman for the Chesapeake Region. I was also Concourse Chairman for the ITC from 2007 till 2017.

Tampa Bay Automobile Museum -Pinellas Park, FL.



While in Florida earlier this year, O'Rean & I visited the Tampa Bay Automobile Museum in Pinellas Park, FL. The museum is privately owned and quite unique in a number of ways. The collection is focused primarily on early automotive engineering achievements, and most of the collection are 1920 – 1930 era European and American vehicles. All of the vehicles are fully restored (or in the process), and they are said to be driven routinely, including the reproduction 1770 prototype steam powered cart proposed for the French military. Technical displays also include a cut away sleeve valve engine design and a number of items relating to rear engine and front wheel drive engineering developments. No T-birds, of course, but I was intrigued by this Model A Ford modified to run on gas or charcoal for use in South America when gas availability was sparse. Bags of charcoal, or charred nutshells, were carried on the roof rack. You can view most of the collection on their web site: https://www.tbauto.org/.
