Can You Count to 157?

One hundred and fifty seven is the number of Thunderbirds and Fords that we had at our 12th Annual Thunderbird All-Ford Car Show on Sunday, July 9th in Kings Park N.Y. Well folks, that's the good news. The bad news is with only a few weeks to go to our show, our sponsor backed out. Rather than beat up the Ford dealer, who has funded us for the last ten years, we decided to go ahead with the show and hopefully break even. I guess the "Show Fairy" was looking over our shoulder. We not only broke even, but we donated \$1,600.00 to our charity "Building Homes for Heroes"!

We had a great turnout! Also, Mother Nature was looking out for us - I think because of the weather, she was out playing a round of golf. No rain, no clouds...cars just kept on coming. It was like Custer's last stand: Indians to the right, and Indians to the left. I think you get the picture.

We had a special guest and his family. U.S. Army Specialist Hugo Gonzalez. Hugo was severely injured in combat in Baqubah, Iraq in June of 2004. He suffered a traumatic brain injury, was placed in a medically induced coma and underwent numerous surgeries as well as craniotomy. He is legally blind. Building Homes for Heroes gifted Specialist Gonzalez, his wife, Amy and their three children a home in Port St. Lucie, Florida in October of 2015. At our show, Hugo broke our hearts as he spoke about his ordeal and recovery. He talked about what Building Homes for Heroes has done for him and other seriously injured Veterans and mentioned that they are targeted to gift a new home every 11 days to our heroes. The work that this organization does is a lifesaver for our heroes. The Long Island Thunderbirds and the Thunderbird Owners of NY (T.O.N.Y.) are proud to be able to do our part in raising money for this amazing organization. We couldn't do it without the help of our members and the car owners who come and support our show.

Both Thunderbird clubs are very proud of what we have accomplished in the twelve years of our Thunderbird/Ford Shows. We have donated thousands of dollars to Building Homes for Heroes and have been a consistent staple on Long Island in the show community. Even though we lost our sponsor this year, to the delight of many, we were lucky enough to find one for next year.

Some interesting early history of our show: The first year of our show, a gentleman named Claude came with his Retro Bird from Canada, and the following year he brought his wife. Her name was Claude also and you cannot make this stuff up! Each year, moving forward, we give out the "Claude Award" for the longest distance driven. Up to a couple of years ago we would just give out a plaque for the award, but currently a \$50.00 BP gas card was donated by Alan Leon. (a constant supporter of our show and owner of a large portion of BP stations on the Island).

At times, the smoldering fires in Centralia, PA are visible. The underground coal deposits caught fire in 1962 and have been smoldering since, reducing this town to almost ghost town status. The tunnel trip takes visitors 1800 feet into the side of the mountain as the guide explains the coal mining process.

Some of us had already departed at this point, planning a stop at the Cherry's cabin in Cascade, MD for the Annual picnic. Quite a nice weekend! Busy and filled with friends and activities.
